On the occasion of the Lectures, the SLMFCE will edit a Special Issue devoted to the philosophy of Sandra Mitchell to be published in *THEORIA An International Journal for Theory, History and Philosophy of Science*, including her Lectures and a selection of other submitted papers related to her work.

Contributions on any aspect of Sandra Mitchell's philosophy are welcome on the topics addressed on her Raimundus Lullius Lectures and also on other philosophical topics to which Prof. Sandra Mitchell has contributed. Some of those are the following:

- Integrative pluralism in science
- Integration of perspectives in scientific models and representations
- Scientific explanations of complex behaviors
- Emergence
- Epistemological aspects of multi-level, multi-component complex systems.
- Scientific laws
- Policy decisions and deep uncertainty
- Many topics of Philosophy of Biology, including functional explanation, units of selection in evolutionary biology, sociobiology, biological complexity and self-organization, and biological robustness
